Secure the property to prevent unauthorized access and protect it from further damage, if feasible.



Choose a spokesperson/point of contact for handling communications between your company and the insurance company.



Keep a log complete with dates and times of all meetings and conversations you have with anyone connected with your claim.



Obtain a complete copy of your insurance policy and read carefully.



Quickly develop a short-term plan for your business (i.e., open in temporary location, shut down, etc.).



Keep receipts for all purchases/services from the date of your loss.



Hire your own insurance claim expert(s): contractor, engineer, and public adjuster.
